

Early Childhood Enrichment 2-3 years

Whether this is your child's first experience in a setting away from Mom and Dad or they are comfortable in a teacher led classroom, this class will be right for your child! Not only will your child be exposed to educational themes that are stimulating and age appropriate, but their social development will sky rocket with the carefully structured activities led each day.

Details of the Early Childhood Enrichment program

Our program for children 2-3 yrs will provide your child with valuable classroom experience to help prepare them for more formal educational settings and more intricate lessons. Social development at this age is very important and many of our educational lessons are structured around social learning. You will see an improvement with speech, independence, responsibility and empathy to name a few. Here are some examples of the educational components you will see in this class.

Literacy: daily story times, recognition and introduction to properly pronounce the alphabet, pre writing, recognizing beginning, middle and end of stories, and name recognition.

Math: daily counting and quantity, weight (heavier vs. lighter), shape recognition and labeling, beginning patterns, matching, and comparing and contrasting.

Social studies: community awareness to include introduction to the different types of community helpers, social constructs, imaginative exploration of careers, personal safety and responsibility as well.

Science: Experiences of basic science concepts like: cause and effect, states of matter, and observation and reasoning. Students will also experience nutrition education, basic human anatomy, life cycles, and physical education which will be experienced in our 6000sq. ft. Gymnastics facility

Social/Life skills: Enhancing independence in areas like clothing themselves, and personal hygiene , using verbal and signed language to get needs met, sharing, taking turns, cleaning up after using the potty, character building, manners, participation in all school activities.
